# CLEAN & PRISTINE Runaway Hill Co-Vid Safety Measures

Runaway Hill is now open with precautions in place to keep our community safe against the spread of COVID-19. We are working to ensure a clean, safe, and healthy environment for our guests and staff.

### **CLEANING**

Frequency of cleaning and sanitizing has been increased for all public spaces.

### **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

Social distancing signs and protocols in place

### **HAND HYGIENE**

Disinfection stations are available throughout the property.



### STAFF SAFETY PROTOCOLS

We are administering daily temperature and health checks for each of our team members, as well as requiring frequent Co-vid testing. All employees must follow the safety protocol and guidelines. Employees are required to disinfect their hands no less than once per hour as per CDC regulations.

### **FACE MASKS**

Hotel guests and employees are obliged to wear a face mask in the public space of the hotel. Face masks are not required when seated at the tables in our restaurant, or within hotel rooms.

### **RESTAURANT**

All hotel guests not in the same party should maintain a distance of at least 6 feet between one another.

Tables in the restaurant are positioned with a distance of at least 6 feet between each other.

Guests are expected to disinfect their hands at the entrance before sitting at their table.

### **ROOMS**

Employees will only enter rooms after explicit permission from the guest, and preferably when the guest is not present in the room.

Housekeeping services available upon request of guest.

All housekeeping employees are wearing masks and gloves while cleaning rooms.

Rooms are cleaned thoroughly in close accordance with CDC guidelines.

All high-contact surfaces and areas are stringently disinfected after each stay.
